106. GUIDES FOR PLANNED INSTRUCTION

1. Authority Title 22 Sec. 4.4 Pol. 107 Guides shall be prepared for all planned instruction adopted by the Board in order to direct and assist the professional staff toward the attainment of academic standards established for a course of study.

2. Guidelines

Each guide may contain, as appropriate to that planned instruction:

- 1. Objectives of the instruction.
- 2. Concepts and skills to be taught.
- 3. Appreciations to be developed.
- 4. Suggested activities designed to achieve the objectives.
- 5. Suggested methods of instruction.
- 6. Suggested curriculum resource materials.
- 7. Assessment criteria and methods intended to evaluate the extent to which learning objectives have been achieved.
- 3. Delegation of Responsibility

Guides for planned instruction shall be given to new teachers and discussed periodically with all teachers of the various departments. Teachers in other departments or grades can refer to guides to planned instruction to determine what experiences students may have had. Teachers are expected to follow the basic structure of the content, allowing for changes as needed.

The Superintendent or designee shall be responsible for the preparation of guides, and shall develop administrative regulations for such preparation which include:

1. Participation by appropriate staff members and resource personnel.
